## **TOUR HIGHLIGHTS**

May 29- June 1, 2024

The Tulsa Race Massacre (also called the Tulsa race riot, the **Greenwood** Massacre, the Black Wall Street Massacre, the Tulsa pogrom, or the Tulsa Massacre) took place on May 31 and June 1, 1921.

This tour will pay homage to the martyrs of the 1921 Tulsa Race Massacre and celebrate the resilience of the Greenwood spirit and the Black Wall Street mentality. It was the wealthiest Black community in America. However, within 24 hours, black residents were attacked and the city was annihilated by mobs of white residents (many of them deputized and given weapons by city officials), bombed from the air and burned to the ground. The Greenwood District trailblazers turned trials, tribulations, and tragedy into a triumph of the human spirit. Their legacy endures...

## DAY 1 $\star$ WEDNESDAY, MAY 29, 2024 $\star$ Dallas / Tulsa, OK $\star$ (Box Lunch, D) $\star$

Motorcoach leaves Dallas (from location TBD) @ 7:00 am for Tulsa, Oklahoma. En route there will be stops along the way for "necessary breaks" (fresh air, a stretch, refreshments, etc.); related Tulsa stories, movies, and motorcoach games. A box lunch will be provided en route. Upon arrival in Tulsa, our first stop is a docent lead tour at the Greenwood Cultural Center. the keeper of the flame of the Tulsa Race Riot of the Black Wall Street area, called the worst civic disturbance in American history. Afterwards, group can enjoy a photo op at the Black Wall St. Mural. In the afternoon the group will check into the Doubletree by Hilton-Downtown. This evening the tour members will enjoy A three course "Welcome to Tulsa Dinner" with a choice of beef, pork, chicken, or fish including vegetarian or vegan options.

DAY  $2\star$  THURSDAY, MAY 30, 2024  $\star$  Tulsa, OK  $(B,L)\star$ 

(Anniversary of Dick Rowland on the elevator with Sarah Page)

After breakfast at the hotel, group will leave for a visit to the John Hope Franklin Reconciliation Park. Our docent led walking tour memorializes the Tulsa Race Riot and also tells the story of African Americans' role in building Oklahoma and displays the long-delayed rendering of the full account of Oklahoma's history with sculptures by Ed Dwight. Next, tour members will visit the historic Vernon African Methodist Episcopal (AME) Church, the oldest continuously-operating church in Oklahoma. It is the only remaining edifice from the massacre in 1921 and the only black-owned structure from the Historic Black Wall Street era.

A delicious lunch is included today.

This afternoon, tour members will visit the **Philbrook Museum** featuring special exhibits related to Greenwood. Additionally, this art museum has expansive formal gardens. The museum opened in 1939 and is located in a former 1920s villa, "Villa Philbrook", the home of Oklahoma oil pioneer Waite Phillips and his wife Genevieve.

After breakfast at the hotel, our day starts with a visit to the **Greenwood Rising Black Wall Street History Center.** The museum is based on a narrative museum of expression and experience featuring interactive exhibits. After touring the Greenwood Rising Museum, tour members can have lunch on their own at nearby restaurants also enjoy art galleries and shopping at unique shops in the Greenwood District. This afternoon, group will be joined by a very knowledgeable local Tour Guide for a half day of sightseeing and activities in Tulsa featuring:

- Greenwood Chamber of Commerce
- Tulsa Race Riot Memorial

- Drive by First Baptist Church (Up With Trees) an American Elm that has been growing in Greenwood for nearly 100 years

## DAY 4 $\star$ SATURDAY, JUNE 1, 2021 $\star$ Tulsa, OK / Dallas $\star$ (B, L) $\star$

#### (Anniversary of Greenwood burning to the ground)

After breakfast at the hotel, with bags packed and ready to go, our motorcoach leaves for a couple more stops before heading home. This morning, group will visit the **Tulsa Historical Society and Museum** which has created a traveling exhibit on the history of the Greenwood Area and the 1921 Tulsa Race Massacre for the purpose of educating the community. Afterwards, a BBQ Lunch is provided. After lunch, the tour concludes and our travels continue back to Dallas with a scheduled arrival time of 6:30 pm.
